The all-welded construction offers decades of maintenance-free service and low cost of ownership. The lightweight hull features built-in buoyancy and requires relatively low engine power for impressive performance.

The shallow 'V' hull provides excellent stability whilst being capable of working in very shallow waters. A durable tubular gunwhale provides additional strength and protection. Slip-resistant 4.5mm treadplate floors offer a generous working area with a self-draining feature available as an option.

The AUB range is available in various hull, seating and console options to meet owner's exact requirements at reasonable cost. As all boats are built to order, customers can specify many extras.

Trailer and engine packages are available, making the AUB a complete ready-to-use solution.
